










Competitiveness of Mongolia 2011







Strongest Criteria

- Direct investment flows inward
- Total public expenditure on education
- Remuneration in services professions
- Investment in telecommunications
- Exchange rate stability
- Fixed broadband tariffs
- Compensation levels
- Mobile telephone costs
- Redundancy costs
- Fixed telephone tariffs



Weakest Criteria

- Government subsidies
- Investment risk
- Pupil-teacher ratio
- Current account balance
- Skilled labor
- Consumer price inflation
- Human development index
- GDP (PPP) per capita
- Country credit rating
- Internet bandwidth speed



Recommendation

- Implementing policy associated with economic cycles
- Controlling inflation
- Preventing asset price bubble
- Diversifying the economy
- Saving Mongolian behavior
- Developing and improving legislation system, combating corruption
- Increase investment in education
- FDI: using it like a channel to import new technology, knowledge and skill
